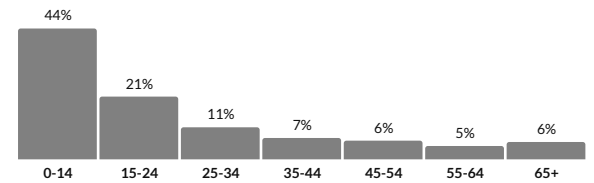

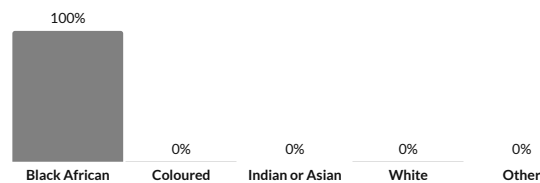

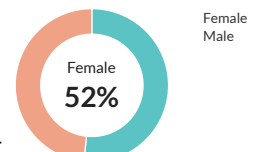
Youth population by race

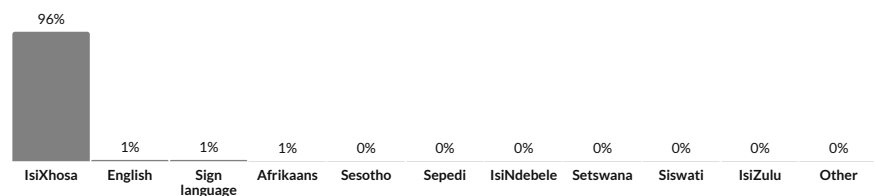

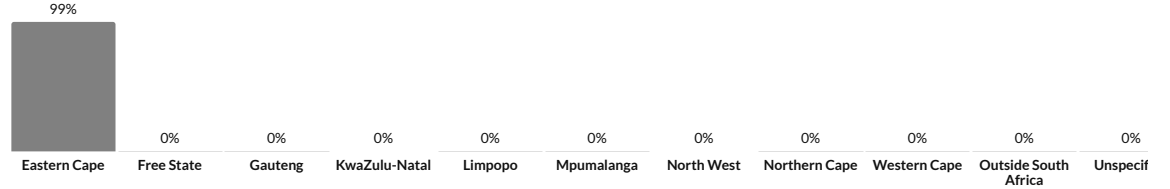

Youth by province of birth



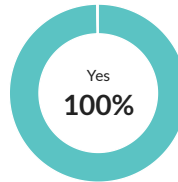

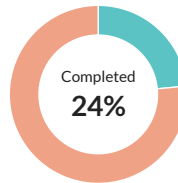

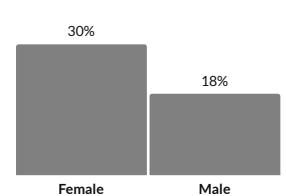

Youth aged 16-17 who completed grade 9 by gender



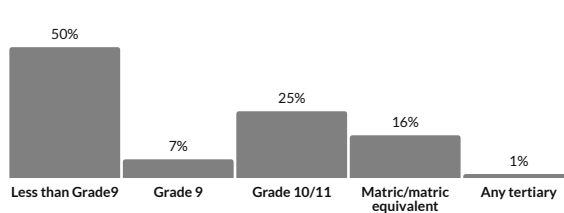

Youth aged 20-24 by highest educational level

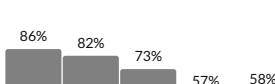

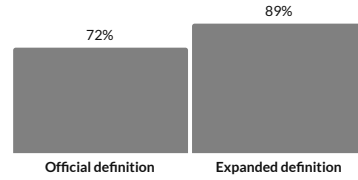

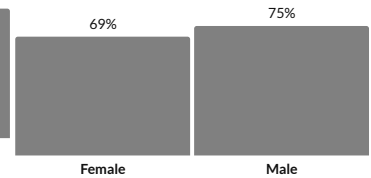

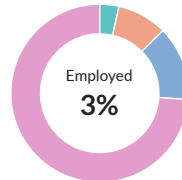

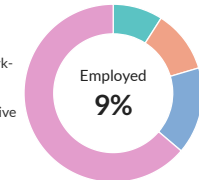

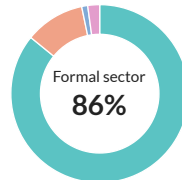

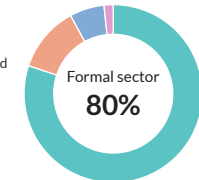

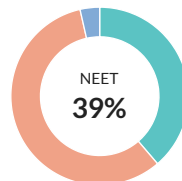

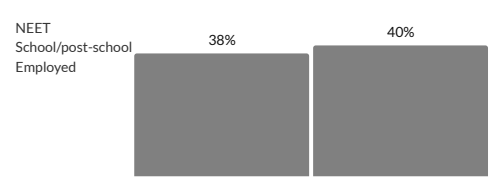

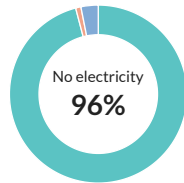

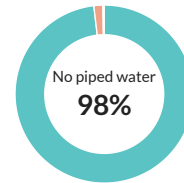

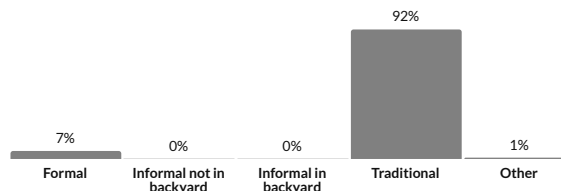

Youth in households by type of dwelling



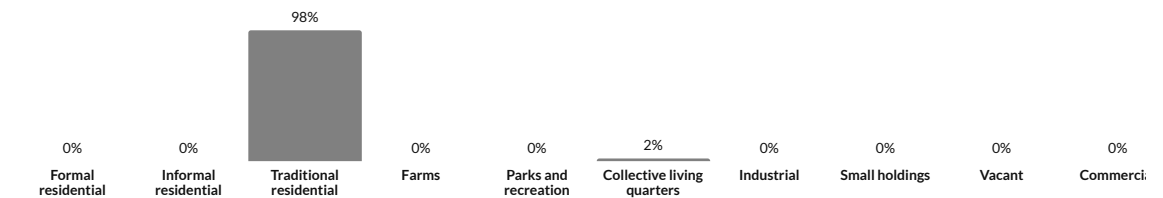

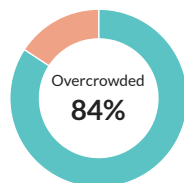

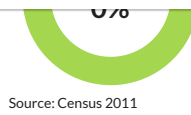
Youth in households by primary means of internet access*

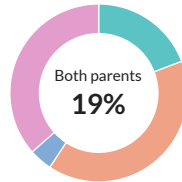

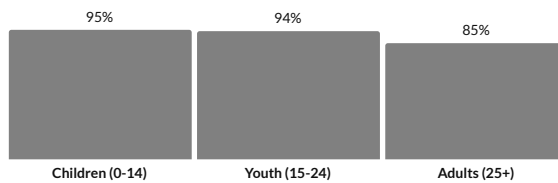

Population in income-poor households by age group

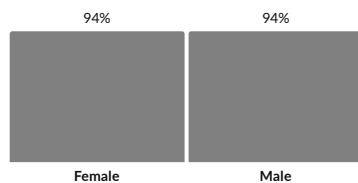

Youth in income-poor households by gender

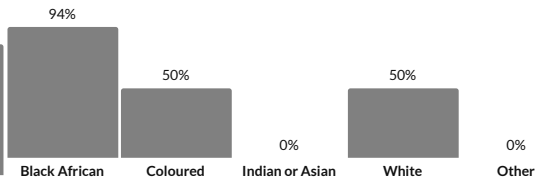

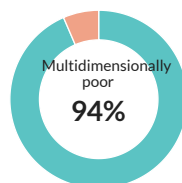

Youth by multidimensional poverty status

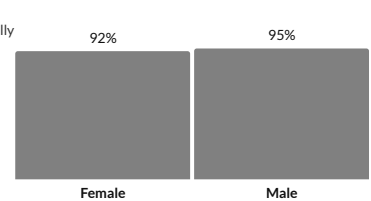

Multidimensionally poor youth by gender

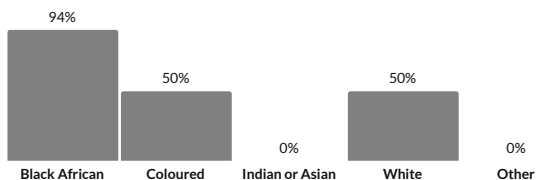

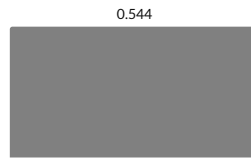

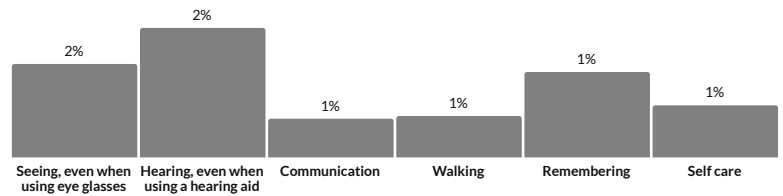

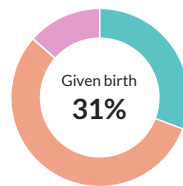

Female youth aged 15-24 by children ever born

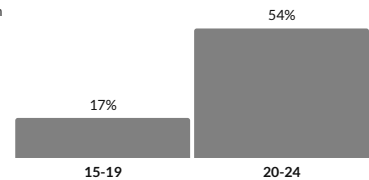
